Spaces are available to persons or organizations that wish to maintain a booth.

Please, complete the attached form and send it along with your Fee by May 15th. Reservations without payment will not be accepted. We have the right to accept or reject any applicant

Early Bird Prices

Spaces with electricity are \$100.00.

Spaces without electricity are \$50.00.

Applications of former booths received after May 15th date will be charged \$200.00 for electric and \$100.00 for non-electric booths. (The reason for the price increase is to encourage organizations to reserve a space in a timely manner. Booth information is needed for newspaper articles, radio interviews, web site, and the Heritage Days Flyer. We are trying to produce the highest quality festival possible, which in turn will encourage more visitors to the Festival and more profits for your booths.)

1. By the Thursday morning before the festival all spaces will be marked, and Booth set-up may begin anytime thereafter. Booths must be set-up by Friday evening.
2. You must provide your own shelter. Spaces are a minimum of 10' X 10'.
3. Water is available from outdoor facet at bathroom building; however no direct line to water outlet is available.
4. No vehicles will be allowed on midway road after opening at 10:00am Saturday and Sunday, or before closing at 8:00pm on Sunday. Pull carts will be available behind food booths for booth use. Each electric booth will be given 1 vendor parking pass to park in the parking lot.
5. Only the Heritage Days Organization will be allowed to sell carbonated beverages + water. Others may sell ice tea, lemon aid, kool-aid, coffee, etc.
6. Electric spaces must supply their own 220 hook-up + transfer box.

All Electric Booths will be given a parking pass.

Fire Police parking attendants in blue shirts will be assisting.

A dumpster (donated by Waste Management) will be located behind the restrooms.
